Objective:

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the supervisor
- Plan dance classes and choreograph dance routines
- Communicate with families
- Support the supervisor and lead with duties such as tracking attendance, development of curriculum etc.
- Organize a dance recital for families

- 2 years volunteering or equivalent
- Standard First Aid and CPR Level C
- Dance experience required
- Leadership experience
- Experience working with children
