In addition, if required, the NBMA may require assistance to prepare for the season, including training, equipment orientation, etc.

Objective:

• To plan and lead the day-to-day operation of the Musical Theatre Program

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Lead and supervisor to write the script
- Choregraph dance routines
- Organize drama games and skills building workshops
- Develop and deliver programming for the Musical
- Communicate with families
- Support the supervisor and lead with duties such as tracking attendance, development of curriculum etc.
- Set up for all events

- Standard First Aid and CPR Level C
- Musical Theatre, drama, and/or dance experience
- Leadership experience
- Experience working with children
