Objective:

- To plan and lead the day-to-day operation of the Musical Theatre Program

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Assistant Lead to write the script prior to programming starting (must be submitted to the director by a mutually agreed upon date before the end of June)
- Choreograph dance routines
- Organize drama games and skills building workshops
- Develop and deliver programming for the musical theatre program
- Communicate with families
- Coordinate volunteers
- Support the supervisor in duties such as tracking attendance of volunteers, employees, and attendees
- Set up for all events

- Standard First Aid and CPR Level C
- Musical Theatre, drama, writing, and dance experience needed
- Leadership experience
- Experience working with children
