### Position: Canoe-Kayak Instructor

The NBMA is looking for outgoing and enthusiastic canoe-kayak instructors for the canoe-kayak program this summer.

**Dates of Employment:** July 5 – August 6, 2021

### Note:

- The canoe kayak program and employment are conditional on COVID-19 West-Quebec / Pontiac jurisdiction Public Health restrictions and regulations.
- These dates / weeks include the program dates. In addition, instructors may be required to help in practice planning outside of instruction hours, equipment set-up, repair, and program closing. In addition, if required, the NBMA may require assistance to prepare for the season, including training, equipment orientation, etc.

### Responsibilities:

- Under direction of canoe-kayak program supervisor / head coach, be responsible for planning practices or lessons for canoe-kayak program participants
- Implement practice or lesson plans
- Ensure safety of participants in canoe-kayak program through implementing
- CanoeKayak Canada's Code of Safety
- Teach and correct kayak and canoe technique following "CanoeKids" and Norway Bay skill development program.
- Prepare Report cards for "CanoeKids" program participants
- Instruction of youth, and children in kayaking, canoeing, etc.
- Other COVID related duties may include:
  - Check-in of participants
  - Sanitization of shared equipment during and in-between lessons

### Qualifications/ Prerequisites:

- Successful candidates must have / take, as a minimum:
  - NCCP / CanoeKayak Canada CanoeKids - Community Canoe Coach Workshop. Other NCCP courses considered an asset.\*
  - Online NCCP Workshop: Coach Initiation in Sport (<https://www.coach.ca/coach-initiation-in-sport-s17259>)
  - NCCP Making Headway in Sport (<https://coach.ca/making-head-way-concussion-elearning-series>)
  - Current Emergency First Aid/CPR-B certifications \*
- Bronze Cross / NLS qualifications considered a strong asset
- Successful instructors will be enthusiastic, outgoing, and demonstrate ability to effectively communicate with children / youth, as well as adults
- Previous experience in instructing or coaching is considered an asset



- Candidates should have kayaking or canoeing experience, and experience instructing / coaching canoe-kayak.

Salary / hourly rate commensurate with experience and certification.

\*Note: If CanoeKids and First Aid / CPR are not offered due to COVID-19 restrictions, this may be waived.
