Position: Tennis Instructor

The NBMA is seeking qualified individuals who will conduct a safe, fun, and effective tennis program based on the “Progressive Tennis” approach. The Instructors, under the guidance of the Lead Instructor, will serve as a resource for participants to achieve the goals of the program and provide a sense of engagement, accomplishment and well-being to the participants.

Dates of Employment: July 5 – August 6, 2021

Objective:

- To assist in the day to day operation of the Tennis program under the direction of the Lead Tennis Instructor.
- To participate in various roles related to other Field Sports events and Regatta events as required.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure the health, safety and well-being of children (and adults) in the program by providing close supervision of all activities.
- Ensure that all participants are learning and increasing their tennis skills and have an enjoyable and beneficial experience.
- Attend lessons and training on time, properly attired, and ready to work.
- Provide sports instruction, i.e. perform drills and demos pertaining to tennis.
- Lead hands-on activities.
- Maintain and ensure safety of equipment and court.
- Communicate effectively with participants, parents, members and staff.
- Inform the Lead Instructor of any concerns or problems regarding participants and facilities.
- Maintain accurate program documentation (incident/accident reports, attendance).
- Actively participate in training sessions, designated meetings and special events.

Qualifications/ Prerequisites:

- Positive, friendly and enthusiastic attitude
- 15 years of age minimum
- At least one year of successful tennis instruction experience (can be NBMA volunteer)
- NCCP Making Headway in Sport.
- Current First Aid/CPR-C/AED certifications.
- Excellent verbal communication skills.
- An intermediate ability and skill level in tennis is required
- Sports knowledge essential.
- Knowledge of the Progressive Tennis fundamentals a plus
- Other experience in supervision, coaching, instruction will be considered



Hours/Salary: It is anticipated that this role will take about 15 hours/week. Salary is at an hourly rate commensurate with experience.
